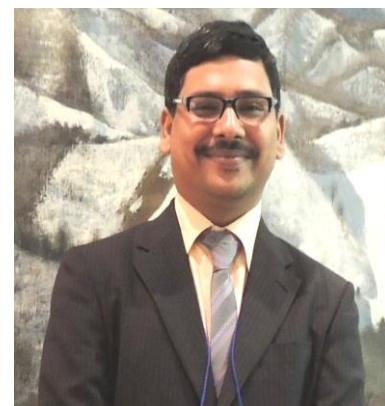

I am a bio-cultural Anthropologist working in the Central and Eastern parts of India. My research generally explores the bio-cultural facet of Food, Nutrition, and Health among vulnerable people (specifically so-called "scheduled tribes" in India). My specific research interest investigates the inter-relationship between food, culture & society and its reflection on human health and nutritional status. As mentioned earlier, I was also trying to explore the impact of agriculture on food and nutritional security among marginalized farmers. I am currently aiming to understand the complex interplay between gender roles on maternal and child health care practices by considering the psychological aspects of both the mother and child. I have published several articles on chronic energy deficiency themes and their bio-social correlations among the scheduled tribes in Central and Eastern India. Presently I am interested in studying the food security issue among the indigenous community of south, south-east and Asia pacific countries.

**During the COVID-19 Pandemic crisis, I am working in "Role of Anthropology in Public Health Emergencies". I am trying to conceptualize the COVID-19 disease as a bio-cultural entity to build a Social and Behavioural Change (SBC) model, especially among the Indigenous community in India, by using virtual platforms.**
